The meeting was called to order by Mayor Tedford at 4:00 p.m.

Mayor Tedford inquired if the agenda had been posted in compliance with NRS requirements.

Mayor Tedford inquired if there were any public comments. He noted that comments are to be general in nature, not relative to any agenda items. No action may be taken on a matter raised under this item until the matter has been specifically included on an agenda as an item upon which action will be taken.

Public Hearing: Tentative Budget for June 30, 2018

City Clerk Cordes explained that NRS 354.598 indicates that the City Council shall hold a public hearing on the tentative budget, at which time interested persons must be given an opportunity to be heard. The budget has been available for inspection at the Churchill County Clerk's Office and the City

Clerk's Office since April 13, 2018. The City Clerk's Office has not received any written correspondence relative to this agenda item.

City Clerk Cordes distributed a letter dated May 9, 2018 from the Department of Taxation indicating they reviewed the budget and found it to be in compliance with the law and appropriate regulations. [The letter is attached to these minutes.] There are four corrections that will be made to the final budget.

The corrections are as follows:

City Clerk Cordes reminded that this agenda item is for discussion only.

Mayor Tedford inquired if the Council had any comments or questions.

Councilman Richardson confirmed that the actual numbers on page 58 are correct and calculated at the 3.17 interest rate, just the interest rate listed was incorrect.

City Clerk Cordes replied affirmatively. The numbers in the schedule are correctly computed at the 3.17 interest rate, just the interest rate listed was a typographical error.

Councilman Erickson inquired as to the projected ending fund balance for 2019.

City Clerk Cordes replied that the projected ending fund balance for June 30, 2019 is approximately 7.7%.

Councilman Erickson inquired as to the reason for the decrease in Consolidated Tax distribution for fiscal year 2019.

City Clerk Cordes explained that the geothermal plant in Churchill County had a major expansion in fiscal year 2018 which generated significant one-time sales tax on the construction materials. No expansion is expected for June 30, 2019.

Mayor Tedford stated that this was a public hearing and inquired if there were any public comments or questions.
