

**MINUTES

The Honorable City Council met in a regularly scheduled Council meeting on the above date in the Council Chambers, 55 West Williams Avenue, Fallon, Nevada.

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Tedford at 7:00 p.m.

Mayor Tedford led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Mayor Tedford inquired if the agenda had been posted in compliance with NRS requirements.

Deputy City Clerk Lee advised that the agenda was posted in compliance with NRS 241.

Approval of Council meeting minutes for November 7, 2017

Mayor Tedford inquired if there were any additions or corrections to the minutes for November 7, 2017.

No additions or corrections were noted.

Councilman Erickson motioned to approve the Council meeting minutes for November 7, 2017 as submitted, seconded by Councilman Richardson and approved with a 3-0 vote by the Council.

Presentation of Life Saving Award

Chief Gehman read a prepared statement into the record: "On June 3, 2016, Sergeant Duane Jardine and Officer Jessica Zamora were dispatched to a motor vehicle accident, where the vehicle had crashed into a local business. Upon arriving on scene they quickly determined the driver of the vehicle, 70 year old Ralph Anderson, was experiencing a life-threatening medical issue and was not breathing.

Without hesitation, Sergeant Jardine and Officer Zamora forced entry into the vehicle to extricate Mr. Anderson. Officers started CPR on scene and when paramedics arrived, they continued to assist with CPR compressions and breathing while the other drove the ambulance so medics could continue working on Mr. Anderson. Their actions undoubtedly saved the life of Mr. Anderson, who unfortunately, was unable to join us this evening.

I would like to commend you both for your swift actions and outstanding work in providing medical intervention to save Mr. Anderson's life that day."

He read the Life Saving Award Certificate into the record: "In recognition of your outstanding and dedicated service on June 3, 2016, when your prompt actions resulted in saving the life of Ralph Anderson. On that fateful day, you provided emergency care through extrication and through the delivery of chest compressions and emergency breathing. This exceptional action reflects the highest standards of personal commitment and professionalism in police service, and is in keeping with the highest traditions of the Fallon Police Department. We have long prided ourselves as an exceptional agency that consistently goes above and beyond for all of our citizens. You have exemplified that philosophy through your extraordinary service and actions. Awarded on this 21st day of November, 2017."

Mayor Tedford stated, on behalf of the people of the City, we thank you both very much for what you did to save that man's life.

Certificates were presented and photographs were taken.

Consideration of application by Juan Galeno-Camacho for a drinking establishment liquor license for Maria Bonita Restaurant to be located at 310 South Maine Street

Deputy City Clerk Lee explained that Juan Galeno-Camacho has made application for a drinking establishment liquor license for Maria Bonita Restaurant to be located at 310 South Maine Street. A drinking establishment liquor license is a privileged license that allows the licensee to sell alcoholic beverages from a fixed and definite place of business for consumption upon the premises only. The application has been reviewed by Chief Gehman, City Engineer Miller, Deputy City Clerk Lee, and Legal and Administrative Director Erquiaga and has been recommended for approval.

Mayor Tedford: Advised of a few upcoming events:


- Dave Munoz Retirement Party on November 30, 11:30 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. at the Convention Center
