UPDATE ON CITY OF FALLON UTILITY PAYMENTS

The City of Fallon is committed to supporting its citizens and businesses facing financial hardship as a result of the coronavirus threat. As such, the City has temporarily discontinued utility shutoffs as a result of non-payment. The City is also working with its citizens and businesses that have been impacted by the coronavirus to help mitigate the effects of this unprecedented situation. These efforts include the waiver or reduction of deposit amounts and the waiver of late fees. The City encourages anyone that is experiencing a financial hardship due to the coronavirus to call City Hall at 775.423.5104 to discuss payment plans and options.

The City also continues to encourage people to practice social distancing by making their utility payments by phone, online via fallonnevada.gov, or at one of these four (4) utility payment dropbox locations:

- Stillwater Plaza, Parking Lot, 2105 West Williams Avenue
- CC Communications, Parking Lot, 1750 West Williams Avenue
- CC Communications, Parking Lot, 879 South Maine Street.
