There is increased uncertainty at the moment while Congress works toward passing future funding legislation.

Our business advisors are at the ready to help answer your questions regarding both the Economic Injury Disaster Loan (EIDL) and the Payroll Protection Program (PPP). Our resources are available to you right now to help you prepare your application, gather information, or work on reporting for PPP funds you may have received.

Adaptability is necessary for business success and we are here to help you maneuver the changing landscape.

There are local grant programs that may be created and we urge you to reach out to your local economic development authority to discuss possible funding opportunities.
