IN THE MUNICIPAL COURT OF THE CITY OF FALLON COUNTY OF CHURCHILL, STATE OF NEVADA

Nevada Revised Statutes Chapter 5 and 266 provide the framework for establishing administrative regulations governing the affairs of the Municipal Court.

On March 19, 2020, the City of Fallon Municipal Court entered Administrative Order 20-01, whereby COVID 19 protocols were established. Due to increasing cases of COVID 19 and Governor Sisolak's directive, all currently scheduled Municipal Court hearings set on or after November 17, 2020, will be conducted via video or telephonic means; decided on the papers; or rescheduled.

By this Order, all in person pre-trial hearings and trials currently scheduled will be continued until further notice.

The Court will continue to hear the following matters through in-person appearances, if necessary:

- 1. In-custody arraignments;
- 2. In-custody bail motions; and
- 3. In-custody criminal sentencings.

The time period of any continuance entered as a result of this order shall be excluded for purposes of calculating speedy trial under NRS 178.556(2) and NRS 174.511 as the Municipal Court finds that the ends of justice served by taking that action outweigh the interests of the parties and the public in a speedy trial. Absent further order of the

Court or any individual judge, the period of exclusion shall be from **November 16, 2020** to **January 7, 2021.** The Municipal Court may extend the period of exclusions as circumstances warrant.

This Order shall be reviewed and updated or rescinded as necessary upon determination by the Court.
