DISCUSSION:

Ron was born and raised the son of a United States Air Force Chief Master Sergeant Don Wenger and Emma. The family moved several times; to include Sault Sainte Marie Michigan, Orlando Florida, Sacramento California, and Ron's hometown, Merced California. Ron has three siblings, Annette Lindquist of Texas, Bryan Wenger of California and Janice Goodman of Missouri.

On January 1, 1980, Ron enlisted in the United States Coast Guard. After finishing tech school, Ron was stationed at Loran Station Fallon Nevada at the end of Soda Lake Road. In mid-1983 Ron was accepted into the Fallon Police Reserve Program, working many hours to earn a level one reserve officer designation, which at the time, allowed him to work a uniformed position and fill shift vacancies within the patrol division. In July of 1984, Ron was hired full-time as a paid reserve officer in the shift rotation of the patrol division.

Ron completed his enlistment with the Coast Guard in January of 1985. In March of 1985 Ron was hired as a full-time patrol officer with the police department and worked patrol until June of 1989, when he had to resign to move home to help care for his terminally ill father. During that time from January of 1990 to June of 1995 Ron worked as a deputy Sheriff with the Mariposa County Sheriff's Office.

After his father's passing, Ron began a relentless mission of returning to the town and department he loved. In June of 1995 a position became available at Fallon PD and Ron jumped at the chance, starting over again in the patrol division.

A short time later in 1996, Ron was promoted to Corporal and was transferred into the detectives division where he served until his promotion to patrol sergeant from 2001 to 2013. On July 1, 2013 Ron was promoted to his current position, Captain, were he served the patrol division until February of 2022 when he was reassigned to serve the support services division of the department. During his time as Captain, Ron attended the FBI National Academy and graduated from Session 257.

Ron has accumulated thirty-eight and a half years in law enforcement service, thirty-three with the Fallon Police Department, as well five additional years in the United States Coast Guard. Ron is happily married to Katrena, his wife of thirty-one years. Ron and Katrena feel blessed to have raised their three children, Rachelle, Colton and Justina in Fallon. Their children have blessed them with nine grandchildren, Ryan and Harley Gomes, Easton, Weston and Tulsa Wenger, Zoee, Kruz, Swayze and Jozie Thomson.

It is with great pleasure that I offer Ronald Wenger for appointment as Chief of Police and bring him before the council for your consideration and confirmation.
